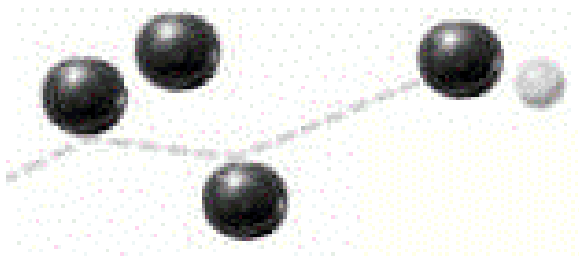

The object of lawn bowls is a simple one. Get your "bowl" closer to the "jack" than your opponent and score points.



The first challenge of bowls is that the bowl curves on the way to the jack just like a curling rock curls on the way down a sheet.

The second challenge is delivering the bowl with just the right amount of weight so that it stops where you want it to.



The third challenge is that the distance to the jack can change from shot to shot and end to end.
